# 'Hope' Mini Cushion



Finished size - 5" x 6"

This is a quick project, I have created it as a mini cushion, pincushion or bowl filler. It uses several techniques, machine applique, hand embroidery, piecing and machine quilting.

#### You Will Need

3½" x 4½" piece of white on white background fabric

3½" x 4½" piece of lightweight iron-on interfacing.

5 pieces 1½" square for the corners and flower

11/2" square of Fusible web

2 pieces 1½" x 3½" of fabric for the borders

2 pieces 1½" x 4½" of fabric for the borders

2 pieces  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " for the back

51/2" x 61/2" piece of wadding

51/2" x 61/2" piece of 'rough' cotton\*

Thread for piecing, applique and quilting

Green stranded embroidery cotton

Small decorative button

Air erasable pen

Toy stuffing

\*by 'rough' cotton, I mean calico or a leftover piece that can be used when quilting, it is not going to be seen.



### To Make Up the Front

- 1. Press the lightweight interfacing onto the wrong side of the 3½" x 4½" background fabric
- 2. Draw the flower onto the paper side of the fusible web and then press onto the wrong side of one of the 1½" squares of fabric. Cut out on the line
- 3. Position in place on the background fabric and press



4. Take the two pieces  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " and stitch onto either side of the background rectangle, press





- 5. Take the two  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " pieces and stitch the  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " squares on the ends, press
- 6. Stitch these strips onto the top and bottom of the background rectangle, press



7. Using the air erasable pen, trace the word onto the background rectangle





- 8. Using two strands of the stranded embroidery cotton, embroider using your chosen stitch Note: I used split stitch for the letters and lazy daisy for the leaves.
- 9. Layer with the wadding and 'rough' cotton and then applique the flower on and quilt the borders of the cushion
- 10. Sew on the button as the centre of the flower
- 11. Tack round the edges of the cushion and trim





#### **Making The Back And Completing The Cushion**

1. Take the two pieces for the back, place right sides together and stitch together along one long edge, leaving 1½" opening in the middle of the seam, press




- 2. Lay the back, right side up on a flat surface, place the front, right side down on top and pin round the edges
- 3. Stitch round the edge with 1/4" seam allowance, curving round the corners
- 4. Trim the corners and turn the right way around through the opening in the back
- 5. Stuff with the toy filling and stitch the opening shut

Further suggestions: instead of creating a mini cushion, use the design to make a mini wall hanger or a coaster. Also, if you wanted a smaller bowl filler, then just use the flower and embroidered stem to make one.
